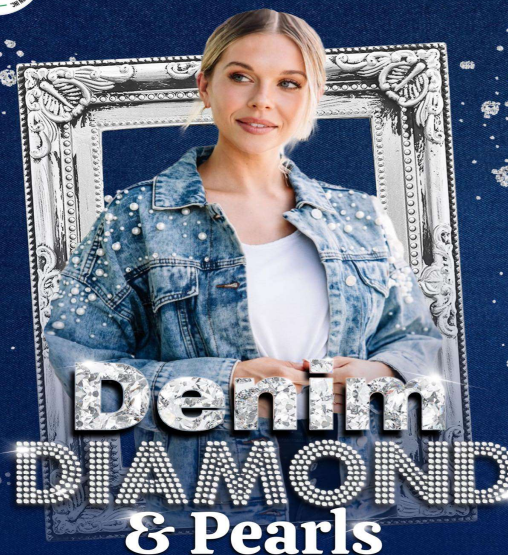

The training aims to update, orient, and equip the Registrars in CALABARZON with the essential knowledge and skills needed to perform their duties effectively. Specifically, the training will cover key processes, including:

1. Special Order (SO) application
2. Submission of enrollment lists and promotional reports
3. eCAV application
4. Curriculum revision
5. Program application
6. Revision of the school calendar
7. Management of off-campus activities, including the Student Internship Abroad Program (SIAP) and the Student Internship Program in the Philippines (SIPP)
8. Application for tuition and other school fees (TOSF)
9. Processing of complaints
10. Administration of student scholarships and grants
11. Application for NSTP numbers
12. Submission of Higher Education Management Information System (HEMIS) data

Considering that some topics to be discussed during the conference relate to academics and instruction, the Vice Presidents for Academic Affairs are also invited to attend.

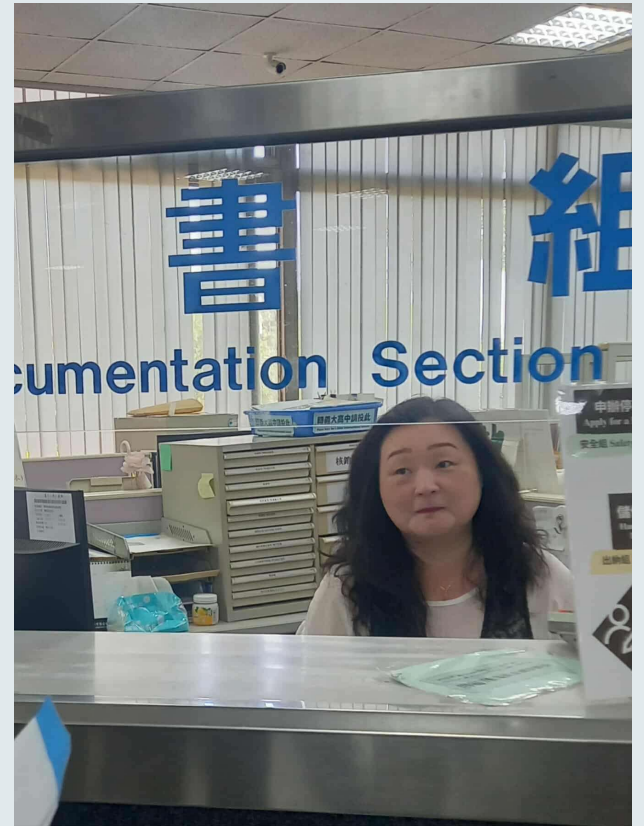

- This close partnership reflects the university’s founding principle of “pragmatism and innovation.”









An automated transcript and certificate printing and payment kiosk used at I-Shou University (ISU) in Taiwan.

Serves as a self-service registrar kiosk — similar to an ATM, but for academic documents.





How It Works

- **User Identification**
Users select their category on the touchscreen (Student/Alumnus, Staff, or Other). Students typically insert their student ID card or input their student number for verification.
- **Document Request**
After logging in, users choose the document they need (e.g., transcript, enrollment certification). The system retrieves the record from the university's database.
- **Payment**
Users pay the corresponding fee through the machine (cash, card, or stored-value payment, depending on setup).
- **Printing**
The machine prints the requested document immediately on official paper with security markings. Once printed, it dispenses the document through the "Document Outlet" slot at the bottom. A receipt is also provided.
- **Verification and Authentication**
After receiving the printed document, users must bring it to the Documentation Section for signature and to have the official school seal affixed.

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School Calendar



1. Process for Developing the School Calendar

1) Government Regulations

- The Ministry of Education (MOE) sets basic rules (e.g., two semesters per year, at least 16-18 teaching weeks per semester).

2) Drafting by the Curriculum section of Office of Academic Affairs

- Fixed dates are included, such as: semester start/end, midterm and final exams, winter/summer breaks, national holidays, and major events (e.g., university anniversary).

3) Coordination with Other Offices

- Other administrative offices (like Student Affairs, General Affairs) review and adjust for activities, holidays, or special situations (e.g., elections, typhoons).

1. Process for Developing the School Calendar

3) Review and Approval

- The draft is reviewed in academic/administrative meetings.
- It needs approval from the Academic Affairs Meeting, Administrative Meeting, and Government approval

5) Official Announcement

- Once approved, the calendar is officially published by the Office of Academic Affairs

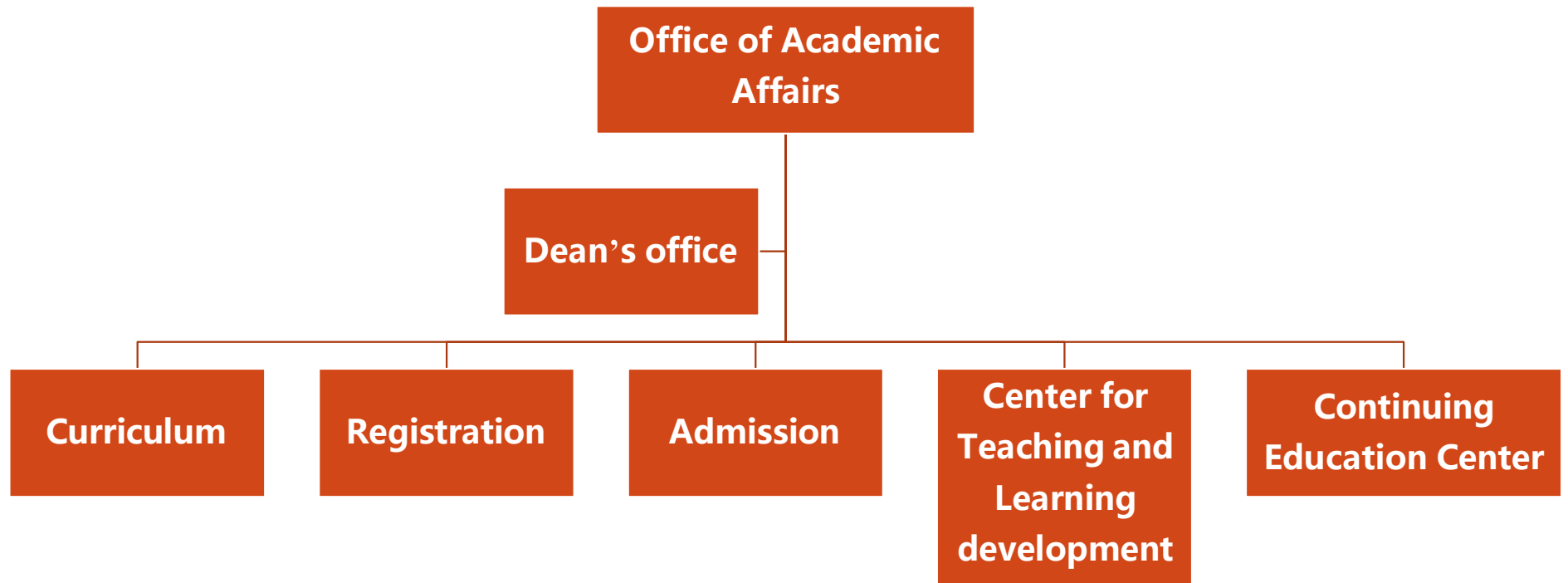

Roles and Functions of the Records Management Unit (Registration Section)

1. Core Functions:

- Student registration and academic records management (admission, suspension, resumption, withdrawal, transfer, etc.)
- Grade management
- Issuance of student status certificates, enrollment verification, and transcripts
- Graduation qualification review, degree conferral, and diploma issuance
- Interpretation and announcement of regulations related to student status and study requirements
- Compilation of statistics on student enrollment and academic affairs

Organizational Structure of the Records Management Unit (Registration Section)

1. Structure Overview:

- Section Chief: **1**
- Staff: **6**

2. Key Roles:

- Review of graduation credits
- Collecting and entering data into the MOE Higher Education Database
- Handling affairs in relation to the total admission quota of the University
- Establishment of new colleges, departments, and institutes
- Process applications for withdrawal
- Management of grades and producing academic transcripts

Office Overseeing Student Admissions

1. Domestic Admissions:

- **Dean's Office of Academic Affairs**

- Holding mock interviews for high-school students
- Holding college information seminars for high-school students
- Holding campus tours for high-school students or younger
- Holding activities related to the University Expo

Admission Requirements for Local and International Applicants

1. Domestic Applicants:

- High School Diploma / Equivalent
- National / University Entrance Exam:
 - General Scholastic Ability Test (GSAT), Advanced Subjects Test (AST)

2. International Applicants:

- High School Diploma / Equivalent
- Academic Records / Transcript
- Standardized Test Scores – Depending on program, may include:
 - SAT / ACT / IB / A-levels (for undergraduate programs)
- Recommendation Letters .
- Personal Statement / Statement of Purpose
- Passport & Visa Documents – Proof of eligibility to study in Taiwan.

- Fall/Spring semester admission
 - Degree (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate)
 - International Foundation Program
 - INTENSE Program

2. Application

- Online Application & Document Submission
- Interview processes (if applicable)

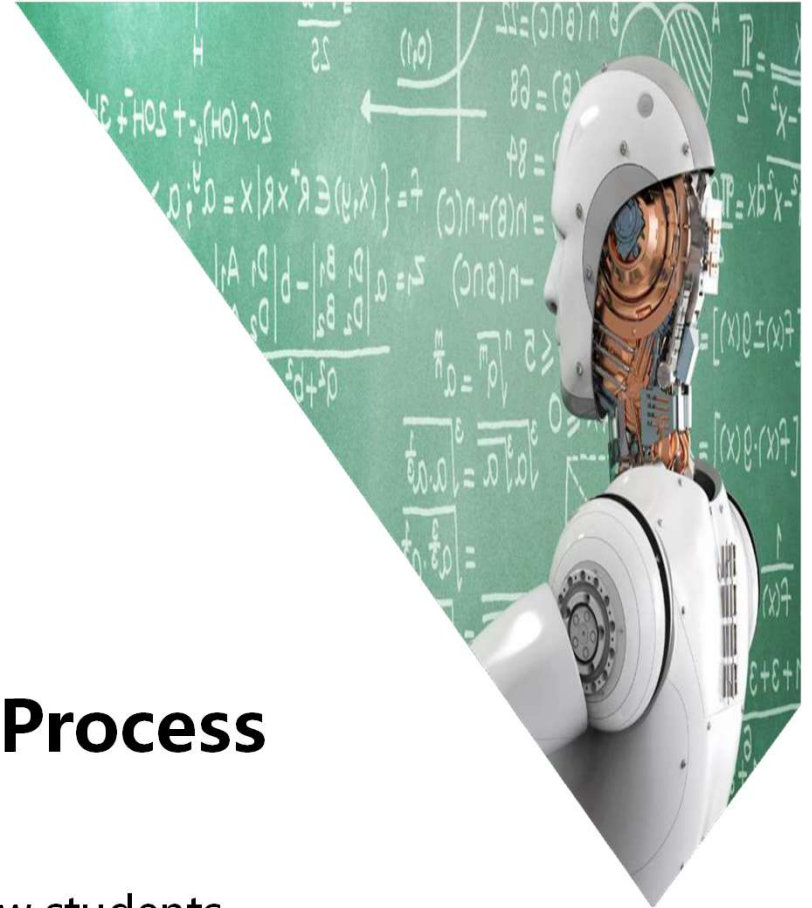

Ensuring a Smooth Enrollment Process

Strategies for Smooth Enrollment:

- Comprehensive orientation information for new students
- Clear communication channels (email, phone support, FAQs)

- Percentage, GPA

Grade Submission Process

Grade Submission Process:

- Instructor Grading
- Submission to Registration Section
 - I-MAP, Score system (online systems)
 - The Registration Section (Office of Academic Affairs) collects all grades and checks for missing or incorrect entries.



Policy on Grade Reviews or Appeals

Review and Appeal Policy:

- Students can apply for a grade review within Ten days after the school application system announces the semester grades.
- If the student disagrees with the result of the grade review, student may appeal to the Student Appeals and Review Committee.



Secure Storage and Management of Academic Records

Storage Solutions:

- All student registration records are fully digitized, with security managed by the Office of Library and Information Services
- Access controls and security protocols in place to protect records from unauthorized access

System for Digitizing and Retrieving Records

Digitization System:

- The digital platform for student records is developed in-house (for I-Shou)

Ensuring Confidentiality, Accuracy, and Security



Multiple steps to protect data:

- Secure Digital Systems
- Data Access Control
- Data Accuracy & Verification
- Confidentiality Measures
- Compliance with Laws & Policies
- Student Rights & Oversight

Security Features in Diplomas and Transcripts of Records (TORs)

Security Features:

- Paper Diploma: QR codes, holograms, without watermarks
- Digital Diploma: Blockchain graduation certificate encryption and anti-counterfeiting

Authorized Signatories for Diplomas and TORs

Signatory Authority:

- The President signs graduation certificates
- English transcripts are signed by the Dean of Academic Affairs
